Town Board Meeting Highlights

March 18, 2022

This special meeting started at 12:30pm and lasted 136 minutes at Town Hall with no zoom. The Board met in executive session for 102 minutes to discuss highway personnel issues. The Highway Superintendent was present for the first 7 minutes of the executive session.

Resolutions / Local Laws:

- 1. Highway Department** — The Board voted 5-0 for competitive reasons to set the following highway salaries to support employee retention: entry level—\$18.75; after 1 year—\$19.51; after 3 years—\$21.07; after 5 years—\$22.80; mechanics start at \$23.05 (no steps); laborers start at \$17.50 (no steps). This is a 1-year agreement with no budget increase. The Highway Department will be dropping down to 7 employees and will stay within the budget allocated.
- 2. Fireworks** — The Board amended resolution #2022-044 for the permission for fireworks display for Royal Mountain. The raindate of the fireworks will be March 18, 2022. (5-0 vote)
